2024 DW Productions Rules & Show Information

- 1) All WSCA Rules apply. Please see WSCA Rule Book for specific details.
 - a. It is available online www.wsca.org
- 2) You will need to send payment via Venmo or by mailing a check when you send in your entry form. Cash is acceptable and no pre-payment is required, if you select Cash as your payment option. No refunds for scratched classes. You can add classes at the show but please sign up for at least 1 class in advance so I have your info entered.
 - a. Venmo: DWProductionsLLC (It should be my logo). Last 4 digits of phone number: 4559. Please note whose account the payment is for.
 - b. Mailed Check:
 - i. Payable to: DW Productions
 - ii. Mailing address: 5211 Red Oak Lane Houston, MN 55943
 - c. All accounts must be settled by 10AM Sunday, when paying at the show. No open show tabs allowed.
- 3) Dress Code: Follow WSCA Rules See WSCA Rule Book
- 4) All dogs must be on a leash.
 - a. DW Productions Staff reserves the right to ask you to remove your dog from the arena & warm-up area for the safety of our exhibitors.
- 5) DW Productions reserves the right to change, add, combine, or move classes at any time.
- 6) You can come show for 1 day, 2 days, or all 3 days. You are still required to pay for a stall at Simon's & Mason city even if you only come for 1 day.
- **7)** No exhibition rides allowed.
- 8) A \$30.00 NSF fee plus bank fees will be charged on all returned checks.
 - a. If you write me a back check, you will be required to pay for all future shows with cash.
- 9) Any checks not cashed within 60 days will be considered void and will not be re-issued for any reason.
- **10)** Must be present or have someone present for awards. No awards will be mailed unless payment arrangements are made for the shipping cost.
- 11) We reserve the right to measure ponies at any given time to make sure they meet height requirements.
 - a. If you have concerns related to pony height in a class, please find Dani in the office sooner than later and we will address any concerns.
- **12)** You can only enter one like class.
 - a. Example 1: You cannot enter Solid horse halter & ranch horse conformation. You have to pick which one you want to enter.
 - b. Example 2: You cannot enter 2 & 3 year old Western Pleasure & your age division class for Western pleasure. You have to pick one or the other.
 - c. Exceptions for Tiny Tots & PeeWee W/T exhibitors. See their rules sections for more info.
- 13) You cannot enter the walk/trot classes and the walk/trot/lope classes with the same horse.
 - a. The same horse can be used for both but must have a different rider.
 - b. The same rider can enter both but must use a different horse.
 - c. If you are showing in the w/t/l classes on Saturday & Sunday, you cannot enter the W/T classes on Friday.
 - d. If a horse rider/combination needs to move from a w/t division to w/t/l or vice versa, Dani must approve. Come to the office to determine eligibility. Show staff reserves the right to make this decision for the horse & rider.
- 14) Walk-Trot Showmanship is the class you want to enter for those going in the Walk/Trot riding classes.
 - a. If you are going for Walk/Trot high point awards you want to enter the walk/trot showmanship class.
 - b. These showmanship classes count toward the Walk/Trot High Point Awards.
- **15)** No membership required to come to any of my shows.
- **16)** You need to attend 2 of 3 series weekends to qualify for series awards.

- 17) Back Numbers: There is a master back number list on my website. Please check the master list before entering a back # on your entry form. If you enter a number, you are responsible for bringing that number & copies of that number to each show. YOU MUST USE THE SAME BACK # ALL YEAR!
 - a. Back number goes with the horse, if multiple people are showing the same horse.
 - b. Leave the back number field blank on your entry form, if you want me to assign you a number. I provide the first set of numbers & then you are responsible for bringing them to each show after that.
- 18) All decisions made by DW Productions are final.
- 19) DW Productions & my staff reserve the right to determine who is allowed to participate in all DW produced events.

Refund Policy:

- 1. No refunds for pre-entries except in the situation of a Vet Out.
 - a. A full refund will be issued with a vet note up to 24 hrs prior to the event minus the office fee.
 - b. If you need to vet out the day of, a credit will be given for the full amount paid to be used at any other event within the same year.
- 2. You are required to send payment at the same time as your entry form (unless paying cash). You will not be included on the pre-entry stall chart if payment is not received.
- 3. If you signed up for any classes & decide not to come, You must email the show staff at dwproductionsllc@gmail.com. Please save my show staff from trying to find you when you are not at the show.
- 4. No refunds for scratched classes.

- 2) Arrival Times:
 - a. Simon's: Arrival allowed after 6pm Thursday.
 - b. Mason City: Arrival allowed any-time on Friday. Corporate & Gold Sponsors allowed to arrive Thursday night after 6pm. No extra stall fee. Electrical is \$35/night.
 - c. Dakota County Fairgrounds Farmington, MN Show:
 - 1. TBD for 2024. Follow the FB event page for updates.
- 3) Office hours will vary show to show. Please follow each FB event for updated information.
 - a. All Friday night entries & class changes must be done by the start of the show Friday night.

- 1) You are not required to pre-enter for each show. However, there is a late fee for stalls, after the pre-entry date.
 - a. Simon's Arena Cannon Falls, MN (Pleasure Show):
 - i. A stall is required to come show.
 - ii. Single Stalls:
 - 1. Pre-Entry: \$75, Limited Double Stalls Available: \$125.
 - 2. Late: \$85 single late, Double \$135
 - iii. Shavings must be purchased from Simon's. \$9 pre-entry, \$10 on-site.
 - iv. You do not have to clean out your stalls when you leave.
 - b. North Iowa Events Center Mason City:
 - i. A stall is required to come show. \$60 each pre-entry. \$70 late entry.
 - ii. Shavings: You can purchase from the facility or bring your own.

- 1. Cost \$9 per bag pre-entry, \$10 on-site.
- iii. If you have a preference on the barn you want to be in, Please include a note for me when you sign up. (I cannot accommodate all stall requests but I certainly try.)
- iv. You do not have to clean out your stalls when you leave.
- c. Dakota County Farmington Show:
 - i. A stall is not required to come show.
 - 1. You can tie-out overnight but no pens allowed.
 - ii. I only have 65 stalls available.
 - 1. They are reserved as first come, first served. Get your reservations in.
 - 2. Cost to be announced on showbill, estimated to be \$30 for the weekend.
 - 3. Bring your own shavings.

4. ALL STALLS MUST BE CLEANED OUT BEFORE YOU LEAVE!

• If you do not clean out your stalls you will be charged an additional \$30 per stall for us to clean them. **Please do not make me do this.**

Electricals:

- a. Simon's: Limited Electricals Available.
 - i. Sold first come first served.
 - ii. I will assign spots and post them with the pre-entry stall chart.
 - iii. Cost: \$60 for the weekend.
- b. Mason City:
 - i. Unlimited electricals are available. Some spots have Water & Electric.
 - ii. Cost: \$35/night.
 - iii. You have the option to get an electrical for 1 night or 2 nights.
 - 1. Corporate & Gold Level Sponsors that come in Thurs night will need to pay an extra night of electrical.
 - iv. Electricals are not assigned. Find a spot you like and come get a cord tag.
 - 1. You can save spots for friends, I don't care!
- c. Dakota County does not have electrical hook-ups. Primitive camping only.
 - i. Camping Form Required. You need a name tag to put in your camper window.
 - ii. Cost: \$20 fee per night to camp.
 - iii. Generators are allowed.

Class Fees:

- a. \$6/class fee
- b. \$10/jackpot class fee
- c. \$10/ barrel sidepot entry fee

Office Fees:

- a. Assessed per horse/rider combo.
- b. Pleasure Shows: \$15/ weekend. Tiny Tot \$5 office fee, if only showing in Tiny Tot classes.
- c. Game Shows: \$5 pre-entry. \$15 for on-site entries.

Pleasure Patterns:

1) Patterns will be posted on my website as soon as they are available & they will be posted at the show.

Barrel Sidepot Information

- This is your opportunity to win some money! 80% of side pot entry fee + 100% of added money are paid out!
- If you enter the side pot, placings will be based off of your run in your barrel class.
 - This is not an additional run.
- # of spots paid out will be determined by the # of entries in the side pot
- We usually pay 1-3 spots in each D. That is 8-12 people that will win money each day!
- Each horse may only be entered once per day.
- You cannot circle the barrel more than 1 time during your barrel class.
- 4D Full Second split between each D (1,1,1)
- Cost to enter: \$10/horse per day
- Must be entered each day, in the side pot, before the first barrel class of the day starts.
- We drag every 10 horses or as needed for the arena conditions. This will stay consistent for all horses that run that day.

Youth & Open Sidepots

- Youth: 17 & Under
- Youth can enter both the youth & open sidepots.
- Open: Any age
- Cost \$10/sidepot/per day

Awards:

1) Calculating Points:

- a. Points are calculated using the WSCA point system
 - i. 6,5,4,3,2,1
 - ii. If a class is not full, points are awarded based off of the number of exhibitors in the class.
 - 1. Example: If there are 4 exhibitors in the class, Points Given are 4, 3, 2, 1.
 - iii. In the event of a tie: The person that received the most 1st places will be the winner.
 - i. If there is a tie based off of the number of 1st place wins, then we review 2nd place wins, then 3rd place wins, and so on until the tie is broken.

a. Belt Buckles for Grand Champion in each Division.

- b. Reserve Champion High Point Awards for each division
- c. Neck Ribbons for each Jackpot Class Winner

- a. High-Point Champion Buckles & Reserve Awards each day.
 - a. Accumulated horse & rider points from each class.
- b. Top 6 overall with the most accumulated series points will receive series awards.
 - a. Awards to be determined.
- c. Must attend 2 of 3 shows to qualify for series awards.

Ranch Horse Classes

- 1) Ranch Horses cannot compete in a ranch horse class & another division class.
 - a. Your age division western pleasure & Ranch Horse Western Pleasure. You have to pick which one you want to show in, you cannot do both.
 - b. However, if you show on a day without any ranch classes you can show in any classes you would like, as long as you stay consistent through the weekend of doing w/t or w/t/l.
- 2) Same horse/rider combination cannot compete in walk/trot classes and w/t/l classes in the same weekend. You can do w/t one weekend of the series and then choose to do w/t/l another weekend or vice-versa.
 - a. The same rider can show in each division with a different horse.
 - b. The same horse can go in both divisions with a different rider.
- 3) General Rules:
 - a. More Information available on my website: www.dwproductionsllc.com/ranch-horse-division
 - A. No hoof polish.
 - B. No braided or banded manes or tail extensions.
 - C. Clipping is up to the discretion of the exhibitor.
 - D. Horses 5 years of age & under may be shown two handed in a snaffle or bosal. Horses over 6 years of age must be shown in a bit one handed.
 - E. Follow WSCA rule for bits.
 - F. Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit. Silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged.
 - G. Attire: Appropriate western attire includes a long sleeve shirt with collar and cuff that has buttons, or snaps that must be fastened at the wrist, a western hat and boots with heels. Adding chinks, wild rags or western scarves are optional.
 - H. Safety helmets (hard hats) are allowed in all classes.

Jackpot Classes:

- 1) All Jackpot classes are NOT WSCA Qualifying but they do count for Weekend High Point and Series Year End Points.
- 2) \$10 Entry Fee
- 3) 50% pay back + 100% of Sponsor added Money Jackpot Added Money may vary each weekend.
 - i. **NEW** FOR 2024: Ranch Classes will each have \$200 Added
 - 1. Sponsored by: Jill's Homestead Fine Leather Goods
 - ii. **NEW** FOR 2024: All other Jackpot classes will have a minimum of \$100 Added.
 - 1. Please thank your sponsors!
 - iii. 5 Spots will be paid out.
 - iv. Payback: 50%/25%/10%/10%/10%

Tiny Tot Classes

Tiny Tot Rules:

- 1. Each exhibitor is required to have a mentor in the arena with them. They can walk right with them or just be in the arena, either is fine and the judge will score accordingly.
- 2. They can share a horse that is being shown in a like class, except if they do PeeWee Showmanship.
- 3. They have to be 7 & under as of Jan. 1st.
- 4. They can cross enter into W/T PeeWee 10&Under & they are allowed to do PeeWee Showmanship 10&Under.
 - a. **NEW FOR 2024:** Champ Show has a Jr. 17&Under Walk-Trot Western Pleasure class.
 - i. If they want to qualify to show at champ show, they need to get a 1st or 2nd place in PeeWee Showmanship 10&Under.
 - ii. Reminder: If they show the horse in PeeWee Showmanship, the horse cannot be shown in another WSCA qualifying Showmanship class.
- 5. Series points are accumulated points based on horse/exhibitor combo for each class.
- 6. Please do whatever is needed to keep them safe. I want this to be fun, rewarding, and safe for them to show in the arena!

Tiny Tot Awards: Sponsored by Wright Shot Photography & Tom & Linda Boisen

- a. Overall Series Grand & Reserve Champion Buckles for each division. Given out after the conclusion of corresponding class at the October show.
 - i. Tiny Tot Halter
 - ii. Tiny Tot Showmanship

- b. A trophy for each class winner each day!
- c. A ribbon for every exhibitor!
- d. Goodie bag for each lead line exhibitor each day as usual 😊

Adaptive Riding Classes

- a. We will accommodate the needs of those showing at each show & in each class.

- d. The most important thing to me is that they come, have classes to show in, and have a great show experience.
- e. Trail class will be very basic with a few obstacles.
 - a. Example: A couple walk over poles, a barrel or two that they go around and then a stop and back. We will adjust based on our riders needs.

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b. They will not be disqualified for going off pattern, the judge will place the classes accordingly.
